Rock and Roll Heaven by The Righteous Brothers

"**Rock and Roll Heaven**" is a song written by [Alan O'Day](#) and Johnny Stevenson, popularized by [The Righteous Brothers](#). It referenced several deceased singers such as [Jimi Hendrix](#), [Janis Joplin](#), and [Otis Redding](#), and has been rewritten a number of times to include other singers. The song was first recorded by the band [Climax](#) in 1973 but it failed to chart. The Righteous Brothers recorded "Rock and Roll Heaven" a few weeks after they decided to reform the duo in 1974 when they were given the song to record. They updated the song to include [Jim Croce](#) (Croach) and [Bobby Darin](#) who had died within three months of each other in late 1973. According to [Bill Medley](#), they were dubious about the song because they didn't think the song had the "old Righteous Brothers feel". Nevertheless, it became a hit for them

Rock and Roll Girls by John Fogerty

1985 According to *Ultimate Classic Rock* critic Bryan Wawzenek, "Rock and Roll Girls" starts out seeming like it will be a typical 1980s song glorifying rock and roll music.^[5] But then there is a twist, he says, and the lyrics then "speak to the mystery of pop music – how it can become a secret handshake between friends, the soundtrack to a memory that means everything.

Rock and Roll is Here to Stay by Danny & The Juniors

1958. With its lyrics of "Rock and roll is here to stay / It will never die"—was originally written in response to attacks on [rock and roll](#) music by some conservative [radio stations](#), that included the smashing of "undesirable" rock and roll records. It has subsequently been recorded by many other artists, including [Sha Na Na](#) (1969) (who later performed it in the 1978 film [Grease](#) as "Johnny Casino and the Gamblers"), as well as in the 1983 horror film [Christine](#).

Rock and Roll all Night by KISS

"Rock and Roll All Nite" became Kiss's [signature song](#) and has served as the group's closing concert number in almost every concert since 1976.

Rock and Roll Lullaby - BJ Thomas

1972. It was written by [Barry Mann](#) and [Cynthia Weil](#). The song is sung in a first-person narrative of an adolescent or adult raised by a single teenage mother during the early years of rock-and-roll. Despite the bleakness of their situation, whenever the child cries, the mother sings him to sleep with a 'sha-na-na-na-na-na-na, it'll be all right...sha-na-na-na-na-na-na-na-na, just hold on tight'. In the second verse, the narrator notes that despite hardships, they'd 'dream of better mornings when Mama sang her song', and that while it didn't make sense to try to recall the words, the loving meaning beneath them was all that mattered.

Rock and Roll is King by Electric Light Orchestra

written and performed by Electric Light Orchestra (ELO) released as a single from the 1983 album *Secret Messages*.

It's Only Rock and Roll (but I like it) by The Rolling Stones

The meaning of the lyrics was summed up by Jagger in the liner notes to the 1993 compilation [Jump Back](#); "The idea of the song has to do with our public persona at the time. I was getting a bit tired of people having a go, all that, 'oh, it's not as good as their last one' business. The single sleeve had a picture of me with a pen digging into me as if it were a sword. It was a lighthearted, anti-journalistic sort of thing."

Jagger also has said that as soon as he wrote it, he knew it was going to be a single. He said it was his answer to everyone who took seriously what he or the band did. According to Richards there was opposition to it being a single but they persisted, saying it *had* to be the next single. He said that to him "that song is a classic. The title alone is a classic and that's the whole thing about it.

It's Still Rock and Roll to Me by Billy Joel

The song conveys Joel's criticisms of the music industry and press, commenting on new musical styles of the time such as [new wave](#) being mere rehashes of older musical styles. It also addresses changing trends and attitudes of the era.

I Knew The bride When She Used to Rock and Roll by Nick Lowe

1977

Old Time Rock and Roll by Bob Seger

It is a sentimentalized look back at the music of the original [rock 'n' roll](#) era and has often been referenced as Seger's favorite song. The song gained renewed popularity after being featured in the 1983 film [Risky Business](#). It has since become a standard in popular music

Your phone and devices are for your convenience and use so if you don't want to be disturbed at particular times or create a disturbance for others consider DND and silent modes.

Android

- Swipe down and look for DND (for quick on/off) or long press for additional settings
- Explore exclusions for people, apps and alarms as well as automated schedules.

Apple

- Settings - Focus -> DND on/off and ... for 1hr, period, also Settings for full options.
- Personal Focus, Work Focus with exclusions
- You can configure notifications on Lock and Home screens as well as alarms and create schedules

Windows

- Search for: Do Not Disturb or Notifications
- Configure schedules, where notifications go, priorities for people and apps.
- There is also a Focus session, in which you can disable interruptions for a predetermined period.
- You can use the Clock app with To-Do List and Focus sessions altogether.

3	NEWS 1 - Domestic Robots will soon do more

In 1966, TV show Tomorrow's World reported on a household robot which could cook dinner, walk the dog, mind the baby, do the shopping, mix a cocktail and many other tasks. Nearly 50 years on, these visions are still a long way off... however,

Experts suggest that within the next decade, around 39% of the time spent on housework and caring for loved ones could be automated.

Domestic robots have become the most widely produced and sold robots in the world. As such, they are becoming increasingly important in our daily lives. Whether it be a robot vacuum cleaner, a robot mop, or a robot lawn mower, these robots are helping us make household tasks easier and allowing us more time to spend with our families. But not all experts agree on the tasks that robots can do. A team from the Oxford Internet Institute asked 29 AI experts from the UK and 36 AI experts from Japan for their predictions on robots in the home. The team found that male UK experts tended to be more optimistic about domestic automation compared to their female counterparts. This was reversed in Japan, where female experts were more optimistic about domestic automation than their male counterparts.

The experts' predictions of tasks that robots can do varied. While many believed that robots could do mundane tasks, such as cleaning or lawn mowing, only 28% of care work, including activities such as teaching your child, accompanying your child, or taking care of an older family member, was predicted to be automated.

As robots become more and more advanced, it will be important to consider what tasks they can do, and who should be responsible for their use. Robots have the potential to take over mundane tasks, freeing up

time for us to spend on tasks that require more human interaction. But care work and teaching should still be handled by humans, as robots may not be able to provide the same level of care and understanding that a human can.

NEWS 2 - Sleep Stories

Sleep is an essential part of our lives, and getting a full night's rest is critical for our physical and mental health. Unfortunately, many of us struggle to find the right balance between restful sleep and a jam-packed schedule. For some, it can feel like an uphill battle.

That's exactly what happened to one woman who had been struggling to get a good night's sleep for years. Her doctor had initially prescribed a short course of sleeping tablets, but she found that they only knocked her out for a few hours at a time, and didn't guarantee quality rest.

Desperate for a solution, she eventually stumbled upon the phenomenon of sleep stories. Sleep stories are soothing tales provided via apps and podcasts, and she opted for those on the meditation app and website Calm.

"I sleep so much better now," she said. "Even if I've got a lot on at work and I'm thinking about various things - like what I've got to do tomorrow - I think it's a comfort blanket."

Most nights, she opens the app on her phone, selects a bedtime story, and lets it play through the speaker. She believes the tone of the voices, how they slow their voices down and leave longer gaps between sentences, has something to do with her improved rest.

It seems she's not alone in her discovery of the calming effects of sleep stories. More and more of us who struggle to get to sleep are turning to tech for help, and it's not just about soothing bedtime stories.

The burgeoning sleep technology market has something for everyone, from sleep trackers and noise machines to smart beds and adjustable mattresses. The rise of the 'bedtime economy' has seen innovation and investment in the sleep tech space, and the products range from high-tech to low-cost.

But for those of us who want to find our way back to a good night's sleep, apps that offer sleep stories are proving to be a popular option. Not only do they offer a welcome distraction from the worries of the day, but they provide a form of relaxation - and ultimately, relaxation is key to a good night's rest.

NEWS 3 - Human Fuel Cells

In recent years, we've seen some incredible technological advances in the field of bioengineering. From nanobots to 3D printed organs, scientists and engineers have been pushing the boundaries of what's possible in the realm of medicine. One of the most exciting developments in the field is the concept of human fuel cells.

Human fuel cells are essentially miniature implantable devices that can generate electricity from glucose deposits in the body. These devices are about the size of a grain of rice and use a specially designed enzyme to break down the glucose to generate electricity. February 19, 1987

The Internet domain apple.com is created. Note that this was a full 4 years before the World Wide Web was launched or microsoft.com was registered

February 19, 1971

The first warrant is issued to search a computer's storage. The warrant allowed the searching of:

- Key Punch Computer Cards, punched with a proprietary remote plotting program
- Computer Printout sheets of a proprietary remote plotting program
- Computer memory bank and other data storage devices magnetically imprinted with the proprietary computer program.

This event would lead to increasingly sophisticated methods of encryption to hide computer files from law enforcement agents.

February 16, 1978

The first computer bulletin board system was created (CBBS in Chicago, Illinois). BBS systems were where a lot of us were first introduced to the concept of e-mail, years before the Internet went mainstream.
