Bye Bye Love - The Everly Brothers 1957

Season 6, E 27 Aired May 15 1979 Potsie Quits School

When his bike's brakes fail, Fonzie stops with his feet and ruins his boots; Potsie drops out of college after an anatomy professor intimidates him in front of the whole class.

Splish Splash - Bobby Darrin 1958

S02E19 Fonzie Joins The Band - Potsie Sings Splish Splash with the band

Rock Around The CLock - Bill Haley & ThE Comets -

Season 5 episode 10 - My Fair Fonzie Aired Nov 22 1977

Storyline - Snobby Cynthia Holmes schemes with her obnoxious cousin, Skippy, to make the Fonz look foolish at a country club soirée.

"Happy Days (1974)" was so popular that "Rock Around the Clock" went back on the pop charts 19 years after its original release. The song, by Bill Haley and the Comets was #1 in 1955, and reached #39 in 1974.

Shake Rattle & Roll - Bill Haley and His Comets.

Written in 1954 by Jesse Stone (Charles Calhoun his writing name). As it hit the charts, Bill Haley recorded his version and spent 27 weeks in the top 40.

Earth Angel - The Penguins 1954

You Send Me - Sam Cooke 1957

SEASON 3, EPISODE 23 - A SIGHT FOR SORE EYES

Fonzie fears that his famous cool will be compromised if he wears the reading glasses prescribed to cure his headaches.

Cooke wrote "You Send Me" but gave the writing credit to his younger brother L.C. (who used the original family spelling "Cook") because he did not want his own publisher to profit from the song

I'm Walkin' - Fats Domino 1957

Its ratings were so low at the end of its second season (and first full season) that it came close to being cancelled. Then Henry Winkler's "Fonzie" character started to catch on with viewers, the ratings took a turn for the better, and the show wound up running another nine years.

All I Have To Do Is Dream - MAde famous by The Everly Brothers 1958

In the 1970s Penny Marshall (Laverne DeFazio) appeared concurrently on 5 different shows; "Happy Days;" "Laverne and Shirley;" "Odd Couple;" and "The Mary Tyler Moore Show." She played Laverne Defazio on "Happy Days" and "Laverne and Shirley;" (she even appeared on "Mork and Mindy" playing this character as well). She also played Myrna Turner on "Odd Couple." She also played Janice Dreyfus on "The Mary Tyler Moore Show." She played recurring characters on all 5 of these shows, something which has never been done before or since.

Lollipop - The Chordettes 1958

The song originated when Julius Dixson was late for a songwriting session with Beverly Ross. He explained that his daughter had gotten a lollipop stuck in her hair, and that had caused him to be late. Ross was so inspired by the word "lollipop" that she sat down at the piano and produced a version of the song on the spot. Beverly Ross recorded a demo with Ronald Gumm (or Gumps), a 13-year-old neighbor

of Dixson, under the name Ronald & Ruby. Ross's mother insisted that she use a pseudonym for safety reasons, because they were an interracial duo.

All Shook Up - Elvis 1957

Ep s01e10 Give THe Band A Hand

In the first season, The Fonz wore a blue windbreaker. Starting in season two, he wore his trademark brown leather jacket, one of which now hangs in the Smithsonian. According to an interview of Henry Winkler by Jimmy Fallon, there were 5 jackets made. Henry has one in his possession.

Happy Days - Theme Song

In summer of 1976, "Theme From Happy Days" was a hit single, peaking at #5 on the national charts.

Trivia

Arthur "Fonzie" Fonzarelli was originally named Arthur Maschiarelli (Maschiarelli being creator Garry Marshall's father's original surname) and nicknamed "Mash." When ABC first picked up the show, they had Marshall change the character's name because they felt that "Mash" might remind people of M*A*S*H (1972), a popular show on a rival network.

Whenever Fonzie was attempting to elicit an answer out ouf someone, and they were right, his response was always "correctamundo" (or sometimes "exactamundo").

The character Bosley from Charlie's Angels (which was on 1976-1981, roughly the same period of time as Happy Days, and the same network, ABC), was named after Tom Bosley from Happy Days. They wanted a Tom Bosley-ish character, i.e. a middle-aged, wisecracking Dad type character, to be the mentor for the three angels, but Spelling couldn't get Bosley due to his contractual commitment to Happy Days, so they hired David Doyle instead.

In Happy Days: Richie Fights Back (1975), Arnold's chef and owner Pat Morita teaches Richie martial arts. Morita would later play Miyagi, the wise martial arts master in The Karate Kid (1984) and its sequels.

3 **NEWS 1** - Hospital in the Home

Hospitals are the traditional go-to when it comes to healthcare, but sometimes the comfort and convenience of home can make a world of difference for both patients and health providers. The Hertfordshire Community NHS Trust in the UK is leading the way with their hospital-at-home service which is making a big difference for everyone involved.

The Trust is working with the virtual ward company Doccla to provide hospital-level care in the comfort of patients' own homes by creating virtual wards run in a simple to use smartphone app. This innovative approach is proving to be beneficial in a variety of ways.

Patients are able to receive the same quality of care they'd receive in a hospital, but with the convenience of being at home. This is ideal for those recovering from surgery, or those with chronic or long-term conditions. They are able to receive comprehensive care without the added stress of going to a hospital.

The service also offers a great deal of flexibility. Patients are able to receive care that is tailored to their individual needs. This means they are able to receive the care they need while still being able to go about their daily lives. Having access to care in the comfort of their own homes also helps to boost their physical and mental wellbeing.

Patients and their carers are provided with medical equipment in addition to a smartphone for recording observations which are then automatically monitored by the control centre back at the hospital.

Hospital in the Home is also gaining traction in Australia.

STINGER NEWS 2 - Rio Tinto under fire for privacy breaches

A data breach story with a slight difference. The Rio Tinto BlackVue dash cam breach has been making headlines recently, exposing user data to malicious actors. While the company has released a statement acknowledging the incident and apologising to its customers, the breach raises several questions about the safety of dash cam devices and the security of user data.

A dash cam is a small device that is typically mounted in the car and records video footage of the car's surroundings. This video footage can then be used for various purposes, such as providing evidence of an accident or accident scene, or for navigation.

In the case of Rio Tinto, the company had installed BlackVue dash cams in its vehicles. These dash cams have built-in GPS, allowing it to log details of the vehicle's location and speed. However, a security flaw in the device allowed malicious actors to remotely access the device and extract the logged data.

The breach of Rio Tinto's dash cam system exposes users to several risks. For instance, it could potentially be used to track the vehicle's location, allowing malicious actors to target the owner or occupants of the car. Furthermore, the stolen data could be used to access the user's other accounts and systems, potentially leading to further data breaches.

Yet again, this incident highlights the importance of proper security protocols for any service that deals with sensitive information. It is recommended that users ensure their devices are using the latest security protocols and regularly update the software for additional security measures. Additionally, users should always use strong passwords for their dash cams, as well as enable two-factor authentication to further protect their accounts.

Peaking my interest...I dug a little deeper into Blackvue dashcams and stumbled on an article in CyberNews.com from January 2020: back then researcher Andy Gill discovered that the default configuration of Blackview dashcams was to publicly broadcast GPS location from inside the vehicle it is installed. The company touts this as a feature that can be disabled as necessary. Apparently by installing the app on your smart device and creating a free login account, anyone can view other dashcam videos live without knowledge or any explicit permission requests. It would appear this setting may be hidden away and not so obvious to turn off.

STINGER NEWS 3 - Is that supposed to happen?

Tesla has come under fire recently as the U.S. National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) conducts an investigation into the company's Model Y SUVs. Reports from two customers have surfaced claiming that the steering wheels of their vehicles have come off while driving!

This is alarming news for Tesla owners, as there was a missing bolt that was supposed to hold the wheel to the steering column in both cases. Thankfully, the vehicles were able to remain operable with a friction fit holding the steering wheel in place. One owner was able to push it back on and continue driving while the other just noticing that the wheel was loose... Who pulls on the steering wheel??

The NHTSA has opened an investigation into 120,000 Model Y SUVs from the 2023 model year. The agency is looking into the issue to determine whether the steering wheel issue is a widespread issue or if it is limited to a few vehicles.

Tesla is cooperating fully with the investigation and has already released a statement saying they are taking the issue very seriously. The company also claims that the missing bolt is caused by a production issue and that no further incidents have been reported.

However, Tesla owners are still concerned and have been advised to have their vehicles inspected immediately. If the steering wheel bolt is found to be missing, Tesla will replace the bolt at no cost to the customer.

As technology continues to advance at an increasingly rapid pace, so too does the ability for humans to create new, innovative solutions for everyday problems. And with the help of a team of researchers at Beijing's Tsinghua University, one of these problems has been addressed in a simple yet effective manner.

The researchers have developed a wafer-like device that is just one centimetre square and can easily be affixed to the throat, allowing barely audible sounds or even whispers to be converted into speech at normal volume. This "graphene-based intelligent, wearable artificial throat" is just 25 micrometres deep and is also able to recognize speech elements such as phonemes, tones and words with an accuracy rate of 99 percent.

The device, which is powered by a coin-sized battery and connects to a microcontroller via tiny wires, relies on an artificial intelligence model to interpret the captured sounds and bodily vibrations, and generate vocalisations accordingly. The device is also incredibly durable, with Professor Ren Tianling, the leader of the research team, claiming that the artificial throat "can be worn over a long period of time without losing its performance."

The potential applications for this device are virtually endless. It could be used to help those who have lost their voices due to illness, injury, or even aging, allowing them to communicate with friends, family, and colleagues. It could also be used by astronauts in space, military personnel on the battlefield, or even by rescue workers in dangerous and hazardous environments.

This is yet another example of how technology is changing the world for the better.





5a TECH HISTORY - WHAT HAPPENED THIS WEEK

March 6, 1939 84 years ago Adam Osborne was born, the inventor of the first portable computer.

March 8, 1979 - Philips introduced the Compact Disc to the world at a press conference in Eindhoven, Netherlands. Sony and Philips cooperated to standardize on a 12 cm diameter disc as it would have enough audio data capacity to hold Beethoven's 74-minute Ninth Symphony.

March 8, 1983 IBM introduces the IBM Personal Computer XT, which stands for eXtended Technology. For a price of \$4,995, it features a Intel 8088 processor, a 10MB hard drive, eight expansion slots, serial port, 128 kB RAM, 40Kb ROM, a keyboard, and one double-sided 360kB floppy drive.

March 5, 1993 - Talking Laptop Helps Blind Student Earn College Degree - In an early demonstration of the impact computers could have on people's lives, the Los Angeles Times reports that a blind student was taking advantage of a talking Toshiba T1000 laptop computer to help him complete courses necessary to graduate from UCLA. After 15 years of going to college on and off, the computer provided Robert Antunez the independence and aid he needed to complete a bachelor's degree in political science.

March 7, 1994 - 29 years ago - Intel released the second generation of Intel Pentium processors.

In 1994, in Biosphere 2, a glass enclosed ecosystem, a group of seven people from five countries began a new study in self-contained living. Their aim was to live within the structure, supported by the several simulated types of ecosystems therein, to provide information which may be applied to solving ecological problems created by man. Biosphere 2 was built in the Arizona desert. The world's largest controlled environment dedicated to climate research, scientists can tinker with scaled-down ecosystems by switching off sprinklers and cranking up the thermostat to learn about the effects of global warming out in the real world. It was intended to be a hermetically sealed ecosystem where several biomes, 3,000 species of plants and animals, and a farm would provide the "biospherians" with all the air, water and food they needed. "At the time, a lot of scientists said it literally could not be done, and after a year, the oxygen had dwindled to dangerously low levels, the farm was not producing enough crops—and the crew was suffocating and hangry. The management team pumped in extra oxygen and used a CO2 scrubber, but wasn't transparent about it, and when found out it received a lot of

criticism. However then, and up until now it continues to provide data on how tropical plants and soil share nutrients, how tropical plants cope under stress and how much more resilient they are to high heat that scientists expected. In the mini ocean they are using probiotics on coral to reduce stress, and bioengineering super corals to be resistant to heat and acidity.

Biosphere 2's SAM project (Space Analog for the Moon and Mars) is currently under construction and will be a hermetically sealed habitat. It's purpose will be to create a self sustaining system where plants, fungi and people produce a precise balance of oxygen and carbon dioxide, with an expectation it will mimic life on Mars.

They hope the scientists who live in SAM will experience the kind of epiphany that was described by Linda Leigh, one of the original biospherians. "She said that, in such a closed environment, you can't help but be aware of every breath you take, every drink of water you consume and every morsel of food you eat because it doesn't go someplace where you never see it again," he says. "It comes right back to you."

March 5, 1995 - The Yahoo! search engine officially launches on the Internet. 13 months later, Yahoo! will hold its IPO at a price of \$13 per share. Yahoo!'s stock will peak at \$475 in January 2000, and fall to \$8.02 in September 2001.



When all of the frogs have been successfully guided to the top of the screen, the player advances to the next level.
