(B) Elvis Presley - (Marie's The Name) His Latest Flame

1961 First recorded by Del Shannon (1957) Hit for Elvis, it shot from 22 to 4, then dropped to 10, then 26, all within the space of four weeks.

Beach Boys - Barbara Ann

First recorded by The Regents in 1958, then the Beach Boys in 1961.

Michael Jackson - Billie Jean

1983 Jackson said "A musician knows hit material. Everything has to feel in place. It fulfils you and it makes you feel good. That's how I felt about 'Billie Jean'. I knew it was going to be big when I was writing it."[4][2] He explained that, hearing it in his head while in his car, he was so absorbed that he did not realise his car had caught fire until a passing motorcyclist informed him.

Paul Anka - Diana

1957 Anka stated in his autobiography that the song was inspired by a girl named Diana Ayoub whom he had met at his church and community events, and had developed a crush on.

Louis Armstrong - Hello Dolly

1964 "Hello, Dolly!" was first sung by Carol Channing, who starred as Dolly i in the original 1964 Broadway cast. In December 1963, at the behest of his manager, Louis Armstrong made a demonstration recording of "Hello, Dolly!" for the song's publisher to use to promote the show.

The same month, Kapp Records released Armstrong's publishing demo as a commercial single. His version reached No. 1 on the U.S. Billboard Hot 100, ending the Beatles' streak of chart-topping hits. "Hello Dolly!" became the most successful single of Armstrong's career, followed by a Gold-selling album of the same name.

Beach Boys - Help Me Rhonda (1965)

Eric Clapton - Lay Down Sally (1977)

Elton John - Little Jeanie (1979)

The Kinks - Lola

1970 The song details a romantic encounter between a young man and a possible trans woman or cross-dresser, whom he meets in a club in Soho, London. In the song, the narrator describes his confusion towards Lola, who "walked like a woman but talked like a man".

Originally, "Lola" saw controversy for its lyrics. Some radio stations faded the track out before implications of Lola's biological sex were revealed. On 18 November 1970, "Lola" was banned from being played by several radio stations in Australia because of its "controversial subject matter", though some began playing "Lola" again after having made a crude edit, which sounded like the record had jumped a groove, to remove the line "I'm glad I'm a man and so's Lola".

The BBC banned the track for a different reason: the original stereo recording had the words "Coca-Cola" in the lyrics, but because of BBC Radio's policy against product placement, Ray Davies was forced to make a 9,700 km round-trip flight from New York to London and back on June 3, 1970, interrupting the band's American tour, to change those words to the generic "cherry cola".

Gene Pitney - Maria Elena

1932 written by Lorenzo Barcelata (Spanish words and music). The English lyrics are by Bob Russell.

Chuck Berry - Maybelline (1955)

Released in 1955, Berry's song tells the story of a hot rod race and a broken romance, the lyrics describing a man driving a V8 Ford and chasing his unfaithful girlfriend in her Cadillac Coupe DeVille.

## Buddy Holly - Peggy Sue

Written by Jerry Allison and Norman Petty, and recorded and released as a single by Buddy Holly on September 20, 1957. Originally entitled "Cindy Lou", after Buddy Holly's niece, the title was later changed to "Peggy Sue" in reference to Peggy Sue Gerron, the girlfriend (and future wife) of Jerry Allison. In her memoir she said she first heard the song at a live performance at the Sacramento Memorial Auditorium in 1957, and that she was "so embarrassed, I could have died."

## Rolling Stones - Ruby Tuesday

1967 Mick Jagger said in 1995. "That's a wonderful song ... It's just a nice melody, really. And a lovely lyric. Neither of which I wrote, but I always enjoy singing it."

### Neil Diamond - Sweet Caroline

Diamond has provided different explanations for the song's origins. In a 2007 interview, Diamond stated the inspiration for his song was John F. Kennedy's daughter, Caroline, who was eleven years old at the time it was released. Diamond sang the song for her at her 50th birthday celebration in 2007

## Bing Crosby - Sweet Georgia Brown

Jazz standard composed in 1925 by Bernie and Pinkard, with lyrics by Kenneth Casey. Reportedly the lyrics came from after meeting Dr. George Thaddeus Brown in New York City. Dr. Brown, a longtime member of the Georgia State House of Representatives said his baby girl was to be named Georgia after the state. This anecdote would be directly referenced by the song's lyric: "Georgia claimed her – Georgia named her." One version of this song was adopted as the theme song of the Harlem Globetrotters in 1952.

## Everly Brothers - Wake Up Little Susie

1957 The song is written from the point of view of a high school boy to his girlfriend, Susie. In the song, the two go out on a date to a cinema (perhaps a drive-in), only to fall asleep during the movie. They do not wake up until 4 o'clock in the morning, well after her 10 o'clock curfew. They then contemplate the reactions of her parents and their friends. The boy fears that having stayed out so late, their friends and families will assume that they had sex together and that in spite of the two of them being perfectly innocent, they've both now lost their good reputations.

## (B) Toto - Rosanna

1982 Note the half-time shuffle which drummer Jeff Porcaro developed for the song. The groove has become an important staple of drum repertoire and is commonly known as the "Rosanna shuffle".

#### (B) Dion - Runaround Sue (1961)

## (B) Dolly Parton - Jolene

1973 According to Parton, the song was inspired by a red-headed bank clerk who flirted with her husband, Carl Dean, at his local bank branch around the time they were newly married. In an interview, she also revealed that Jolene's name and appearance are based on that of a young fan who came on stage for her autograph.

Co-written by Nicky Chinn and Mike Chapman. Although it later because a hit for British Band Smokie, this is the originally released version by Australian pop band New World in 1972.

Rod Stewart - Maggie May (Rod Stewart was at the Perth Arena on Mar 11 2023)

1971 "Maggie May" expresses the ambivalence and contradictory emotions of a boy involved in a relationship with an older woman and was written from Stewart's own experience.

3	NEWS 1 - Operation Cookie Monster has a win!
---	--

This week, a huge international law enforcement operation involving 17 countries has shut down the Genesis Market, sending a clear message that this kind of criminal activity will not be tolerated. Led by the FBI in the US and the Dutch National Police, the operation included the UK's National Crime Agency (NCA), the Australian Federal Police, and law enforcement from other countries across Europe.

The Genesis Market was one of the most notorious criminal marketplaces in the world, used by online fraudsters to buy passwords, IP addresses, and other data which make up a victim's "digital fingerprints". For as little as a single dollar, fraudsters could purchase personal information which allowed them to log into someone's bank and shopping accounts without their knowledge.

At dawn on Tuesday this week, the NCA conducted raids across the country, arresting 24 people who are suspected of being users of the Genesis Market. This included two men aged 34 and 36 in Grimsby, Lincolnshire, who have been arrested on suspicion of fraud and computer misuse.

Globally, 200 searches were carried out and 120 people were arrested.

On Wednesday, anyone logging onto the Genesis website saw a message which read: "Operation Cookie Monster. This website has been seized."

Genesis Market had 80 million sets of credentials and digital fingerprints up for sale, with the NCA calling it "an enormous enabler of fraud".

The closure of the Genesis Market is a major success for law enforcement and a huge blow to online fraudsters seeking to abuse people's personal data. It is now more important than ever to ensure that our online accounts remain secure, and to take action if we suspect that our data may have been compromised.

## STINGER NEWS 2 - Space travel options lessen by one

It is a sad day for the space industry, as British billionaire Sir Richard Branson's rocket company Virgin Orbit has filed for bankruptcy in the US after failing to secure new investment. This announcement comes as a shock to many, as the company had recently celebrated the success of its first-ever launch from UK soil earlier this year.

For those unfamiliar, Virgin Orbit is a satellite launch company based in California, and it had ambitions to become a major player in the global space industry. The company had a workforce of 750 employees, which it had to reduce by 85% after the bankruptcy filing.

The challenges faced by Virgin Orbit were twofold. Firstly, the company faced a highly competitive market, with big names such as SpaceX and Boeing leading the way. Secondly, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a devastating effect on the global economy, making it hard for the company to secure new investors or partners.

STINGER	NEWS 3 - TikTok to go

Australian officials must delete viral video app TikTok from work devices following advice from intelligence and security agencies.

In a statement, Attorney-General Mark Dreyfus said the ban would come into effect as soon as practicable.

"Exemptions will only be granted on a case-by-case basis and with appropriate security mitigations in place," he said. A number of government departments had already prohibited the app from work devices.

Australia is the last of the Five Eyes (intelligence alliance US, UK, Canada, Australia and New Zealand) partners to ban the app from public servants' devices.

Mr Dreyfus' confirmation comes after a security review into social media apps, including TikTok, was handed to the government last month.

The Attorney-General said the review's recommendations, which have not been made public, were still being considered by the government. It's understood however, the review will not be considering a broad ban of any social media apps for the everyday Australian.

## STINGER NEWS 4 - Service NSW data leak

You may recall an article we ran a few weeks back regarding a Service NSW app and how it promised to be a safe and amazing way to access government services in the NSW. Well...

A NSW government department has issued a warning to thousands of customers that their personal data may have been 'exposed'.

In an email sent to 3700 affected customers on Monday and seen by NCA NewsWire, Service NSW's chief executive Greg Wells said an update to the website on March 20 may have exposed their information for 90 minutes.

"Unfortunately the update resulted in some customers' information being visible to other customers who were logged in to the website between 1.20pm and 2.54pm," Mr Wells said.

The privacy breach could include drivers licence, vehicle registration, childrens names or mobile numbers. So, not another cyber attack, just a data leak due to an incompetent deployment strategy. It's kind of a refreshing change, don't you think?

## 1985 April 5

SATAN is released on the internet. Dan Farmer and Wietse Venema release to the Internet the Security Administrator Tool for Analysing Networks, known by its acronym, SATAN. SATAN is a network scanner for investigating the vulnerability of remote systems.

#### 1989 April 5

David Letterman's Late Night show became the first TV show to broadcast in Dolby Surround Sound. Incidentally his guests included Phil Hartman and Donald Trump.

#### 1994 April 4

19 years to the day after Microsoft was formed, Marc Andreessen and Jim Clark create the Mosaic Communications Corporation, which will later be renamed Netscape Communications Corporation. Netscape Navigator went on to become an early and very popular internet browser.

#### 1975 April 4

As alluded to in the previous article, Microsoft is founded as a partnership between Bill Gates, age 19, and Paul Allen, age 22, in Albuquerque, New Mexico. The company was created to develop a version of the BASIC programming language for the MITS Altair microcomputer, and it was the first product they sold at Microsoft.

#### 1973 April 3

Martin Cooper, considered the "father of the cellular phone", makes the first cell phone call on a New York City street.

#### 1976 April 1

The Apple Computer company was formed by Steve Jobs and Steve Wozniak in order to sell their personal computer kits, later known as the Apple I computer, launching the personal computer revolution.

The Recording Industry Association of America announced that Pink Floyd's 1973 album The Dark Side Of The Moon had become the fourth biggest-selling album in US history and had passed the 13 million mark in sales. The album has sold more than 25 million copies worldwide.

# 7 FUTURE TECH from the Innovation Hub - Smart Contact Lenses

The ultimate goal of smart contact lenses and smart glasses is to free us from having to hold our mobile phone in our hand. By utilising wearable technology, "invisible computing" is revolutionising the way we interact with technology. In this space, technology will adapt to the user's needs and body only displaying information when needed. Think "The Terminator" and the AR view he had when looking around or a head-up display in your car.

The lenses will cover the entire eye (rather than just the pupil) and will respond to where you look in order to process various commands like search, zoom and match. Aside from the cool factor, they will additional features including:

- <u>Dynamic focus</u>. The lenses will detect whether the wearer is reading a nearby text or looking at an object in the distance and focus automatically.
- <u>Health monitoring</u>, measurement of glucose, eye pressure, or eye temperature. In the future, these lenses may even be able to detect tumour markers.
- <u>Augmented and mixed reality</u>. As soon as contact lenses can display complex images and modulate their opacity level, a user will be able to see virtual objects.
- <u>Basic applications</u> such as compasses, map directions, or calendar reminders are now constrained to the cell phone or computer.
- <u>Medication administration</u> for the treatment of diseases such as glaucoma.

## 9 TECH - THE ABSURD - What's it like to die?

The new Passing Electrical Storms exhibit in Melbourne, Australia, is giving people an experience that is truly unique and unlike anything they've ever experienced before. The experience, created by Shaun Gladwell, is a virtual reality simulation that is aiming to provide people with a simulated experience of what it may be like to die.

The extended reality (XR) experience that Gladwell has created is described as being "meditative and unsettling" – a sentiment that is echoed by those who have already taken part in the experience.

Participants are hooked up to heart rate monitors and can have staff get them out at any time.

One TikToker, known as croom12, has already taken part in the experience and has described it in detail. They explained that people are "laid down, the bed vibrates, you flatline" before doctors surround you and simulate failing to revive you. After this, "you float up past them into space" as part of the virtual reality experience.

The experience is part of the Melbourne Now event, which is being held at the National Gallery of Victoria. The experience is unique and perhaps provides an insight into what death may be like. It's certainly an experience that will stay with you long after you leave.
