3	12:23	NEWS 1 - Phone scams up and down

Have you recently noticed an increase in scam sms messages?

The Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) has recently taken action against three telcos in response to compliance failures that allowed scammers to send SMS road toll, Medicare, and Australia Post impersonation scams to unsuspecting consumers. The three telcos in question are Sinch Australia Pty Ltd, Infobip Information Technology Pty Ltd, and Phone Card Selector Pty Ltd.

According to ACMA, its investigations found that these telcos allowed SMS to be sent using text-based sender IDs without sufficient checks to ensure they were being used legitimately. As a result, scammers were able to exploit this loophole and send fraudulent messages to individuals, posing as legitimate organisations such as Australia Post and Medicare.

Infobip was found to be the biggest offender, allowing a staggering 103,146 non-compliant SMS to be sent. Sinch allowed 14,291.

The ACMA has taken swift action against these telcos, imposing hefty fines and requiring them to take steps to prevent such compliance failures from occurring again in the future. This is a significant step in the fight against SMS scams and serves as a warning to other telcos to tighten their compliance measures.

The 2023/24 budget was released last week with a sizable chunk devoted to technological initiatives. Diving into some of these areas, there's:

\$116m (over 5 years) for the Department of Industry, Science, and Resources to "support the development of critical technologies in Australia to drive economic growth, boost technology industries, and support the creation of new jobs". This includes \$101m to help businesses broadly support quantum computing and AI.

\$14m over 4 years to setup the Powering Australia Industry Growth Centre as part of the "Australian Made Battery Plan"

\$132m over 4 years to STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) scheme with \$91 million being used at schools over the next few years to build better IT platforms.

\$134m (over four years) for the Office of the eSafety Commissioner to continue doing its thing.

\$392m (over four years) to help small businesses and startups commercialise their ideas and grow their operations.

\$86m (over four years) to combat scams and online fraud.

\$26m for work in the DigitalID space

\$134m for our old favourite MyGov.



Touch IoT - enabled by wireless self-sensing and haptic-reproducing electronic skin

Tactile sensing Haptic feedback Wireless

Tactile sensations are essential to our daily interactions with the world. From the warm embrace of a loved one to the firm grip of a handshake, touch is a fundamental aspect of human connection. However, in a world increasingly reliant on technology, physical touch is becoming less common. That's where wireless touch perception comes in.

Researchers have developed a <u>wireless self-sensing and haptic-reproducing electronic skin</u> (e-skin) that could revolutionise the way we interact with the world. This flexible and self-sensing actuator provides an integrated function in both tactile sensing and haptic feedback. When this e-skin is dynamically pressed, the actuator generates an induced voltage as tactile information. Via wireless communication, another e-skin can receive this tactile data and run a synchronised haptic reproduction. Thus, touch can be wirelessly conveyed in both directions between two users as a touch intercom.

What's truly remarkable about this technology is that it can be connected to various smart devices, creating a touch internet of things. With this, one-to-one and one-to-multiple touch delivery can be realised. This wireless touch presents huge potentials in remote touch video, medical care, and assistance.

Imagine a world where a doctor can diagnose a patient remotely by feeling their symptoms through a wireless e-skin. Or where a loved one can hold the hand of a family member who is miles away. This technology could bring us one step closer to a world where physical touch is not limited by distance.

The possibilities of wireless touch perception are endless and could drastically change the way we communicate and interact with each other. While physical touch will always be irreplaceable, this technology could bring us one step closer to bridging the gap between physical and digital communication.



Can I replace my phone battery?

Wordscapes is a word puzzle video game created by the American studio PeopleFun, available on Android and IOS. Wordscapes was a top 100 ranked game on the Google Play Store, and the App Store. As of 2020, over 14 million people have played Wordscapes.

It is a mix of Boggle and crossword puzzles.

To solve the puzzle, the player must find every listed word using the letters that are located in the circle at the bottom of the screen. There are anywhere from 3 to 7 letters in the circle, depending on the level being played. You drag your finger around to spell out the words.

There are also bonus words, which the player can solve for extra coins.

The game currently contains 6,000 levels and an infinite number of extra

master levels that players can access after completing the first 6,000.

The game publishes a daily puzzle for each day to keep you engaged.

Aretha Franklin - Freeway Of Love 1985

Born 1942, she was the "Queen of Soul"

Her father was a Baptist minister and circuit preacher, while her mother was an accomplished piano player and vocalist. Both Mr. and Mrs. Franklin had children from prior relationships in addition to the four children they had together. The Franklins had a troubled marriage due to Mr. Franklin's infidelities, and they separated when Aretha was about 6 and her mother died before her 10th birthday.

Aretha's was mother to 4 boys. She was pregnant at age 12, and had Clarence. She had her second child at 15, Edward.

Owing to the pink Cadillac appearing on the cover art and several times in the lyrics, more than 100 pink Cadillacs accompanied Franklin in her funeral procession in August 2018.

Bette Midler - Miss Otis Regrets 1934/1990

Bette Midler was born December 1, 1945 in Honolulu, Hawaii, where her family was one of the few Jewish families in a mostly Asian neighborhood. Her mother, Ruth, was a seamstress and housewife, and her father, Fred Midler, worked at a Navy base in Hawaii as a painter, and also painted houses.

Midler married artist Martin von Haselberg on December 16, 1984. The two have one daughter, actress Sophie von Haselberg (best known for co-starring in the Woody Allen film Irrational Man)
