The Australian House of Representatives Standing Committee on Employment, Education and Training has recently launched an inquiry into the use of generative artificial intelligence in the Australian education system. Any child would dream of donning an Iron Man suit to become a hero for a day. And many workers involved in heavy lifting would also love to get their hands on similar technology.

Fortunately, what once was constrained to the realm of science-fiction is steadily becoming a reality with technological projects such as the one heralded by Sarcos Robotics, an American company developing robotic systems for work environments. The company recently launched its new exoskeleton for construction workers and other heavy industries.

Going by the name of Guardian XO, it promises stunning features that bring the power of machines and human intelligence and mobility together.

The Guardian XO exoskeleton is a groundbreaking innovation that has the potential to revolutionise the way heavy lifting and construction work is done. It is a wearable, full-body exoskeleton that provides the operator with superhuman strength, endurance and agility. It is designed to help workers lift and move heavy objects with ease, reducing the risk of injuries and increasing productivity.

The exoskeleton is made of lightweight materials that are comfortable to wear, even for extended periods of time. It has hydraulic actuators that amplify the operator's movements, allowing them to lift objects weighing up to 200 pounds with minimal effort. The Guardian XO also has built-in sensors that provide the operator with real-time feedback on their movements and posture, ensuring that they are using the exoskeleton in the most efficient and safe way possible.

Incidentally, Ford has the EksoVest used in its car factories and LG has the CLOi SuitBot aimed at helping people with muscular problems and arthrosis (osteoarthritis).

**Should you?** Sometimes you should restart and force close your apps. Updates sometime force a restart

**How?** Find the power button. Usually long press the power button (3-5) seconds until you see a popup on the screen with options to Reboot/ Shutdown/ Lockdown/ Emergency then choose Shutdown.

iPhone has a slide to switch off option.

To turn it back on, you often need to hold the power button again 3-5 seconds then wait for startup. Make sure you unlock to fully start it up.
